REGULATIONS

WORLD BELBOGLI KURASH CHAMPIONSHIP AMONG BOYS AND GIRLS AGED 16–17 (born in 2009–2010)

1. Goals and Objectives

To promote and develop Belbogli Kurash worldwide;
To strengthen and develop international humanitarian and sports relations, as well as intercultural exchange among peoples of different countries.

2. Venue and Dates of the Competition

Venue: Fergana City, Republic of Uzbekistan Dates: June 9–11, 2026

3. Organizers of the Competition

The organization and conduct of the competition shall be carried out by the Ministry of Sports of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the Khokimiyat of Fergana Region of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the World Association of Belbogli Kurash, the Asian Confederation of Belbogli Kurash, and the Belbogli Kurash Federation of Uzbekistan.

4. Eligibility and Participation Requirements

Athletes born in 2009–2010 who are citizens of the country represented by the national Belbogli Kurash federation (association) are eligible to participate in the competition. Official delegation composition from national federations:

Boys (Classical Style): 45 kg, 50 kg, 55 kg, 60 kg, 65 kg, 71 kg, 77 kg, 85 kg, 95 kg, +95 kg.

Girls (Classical Style): 44 kg, 48 kg, 52 kg, 57 kg, 63 kg, 70 kg, +70 kg.

Delegation Members: Head of Delegation – 1 person Coaches – 2 persons Referees – 2 persons Each country may enter up to two athletes in each weight category.

Each delegation must provide the Organizing Committee with: Two national flags (120 cm × 180 cm);

An electronic version of the national anthem recording.

5. Competition Rules and Format

The competitions shall be held in the classical style of Belbogli Kurash among boys and girls in accordance with the current International Belbogli Kurash Rules under the supervision of the refereeing panel of the Belbogli Kurash Federation of Uzbekistan.

In each weight category, first place, second place, and two third places shall be awarded.

6. Financing

Expenses related to organizing and conducting the competition shall be covered jointly by the Asian Confederation of Belbogli Kurash, the Khokimiyat of Fergana Region of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the Sports Department of Fergana Region, and the Belbogli Kurash Federation of Uzbekistan, and distributed according to additional written agreements between the parties. Travel expenses of the participants shall be covered by the sending organizations. The host side shall

provide accommodation and meals for the following representatives from national federations:

- 17 athletes;
- 1 head of delegation;
- 2 coaches;
- 2 referees.

7. Awards

Athletes who place 1st, 2nd, and two 3rd places in their respective weight categories shall be awarded certificates, medals, and valuable prizes from the Organizing Committee. The coach of the champion shall also receive a certificate.

8. Safety of Participants and Spectators

The safety of participants and spectators during sports competitions shall be ensured in accordance with the official safety regulations for conducting sports events. The Chief Referee of the competition is required to:

- Inspect the readiness and condition of the competition venue, equipment, secretariat rooms, and referees' facilities;

- Verify the availability of the official approval certificate confirming the suitability of the sports venue for sporting events;

- Sign the official readiness report of the sports facility for the competition;

- Start the competition only if a duty doctor or medical team is present;

- Allow athletes to participate only upon presentation of the original accident, life, and health insurance policy (insurance shall be arranged by the sending organizations).

Responsibility for personal safety, including insurance coverage, lies solely with the participant. The organizing committee and refereeing panel shall not be held responsible for any physical injury, loss of life, property damage, or loss of belongings during the competition. Owners and operators of sports facilities shall ensure public order and public safety.

9. Submission of Applications

Preliminary applications containing information about athletes (including referees and coaches/representatives) participating in the international competition must be submitted to the Organizing Committee no later than 10 days before the start of the competition. Contact Information:
