ASIAN CHAMPIONSHIP IN BELBOGLI KURASH AMONG MEN AND WOMEN

1. Goals and Objectives

Promotion and development of the sport of Belbogli Kurash worldwide; strengthening and development of international humanitarian and sports relations, as well as intercultural exchange among peoples of different countries.

2. Venue and Dates

Venue: Fergana City, Republic of Uzbekistan.

Dates: June 11–13, 2026.

3. Organizers of the Competition

The organization and management of the competition shall be carried out by the Ministry of Sports of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the Khokimiyat of Fergana Region of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the Asian Confederation of Belbogli Kurash, and the Uzbekistan Federation of Belbogli Kurash.

4. Requirements for Participants and Conditions of Admission

Men and women holding citizenship of their respective countries and represented by their national federation (association) are eligible to participate in the competition. Official composition of delegations from national federations:

Asian Championship Belbogli Kurash (men, classical style): 57, 62, 68, 75, 82, 90, 100, +100 kg

Belbogli Kurash (women, classical style): 52, 58, 66, 76, +76 kg

Head of Delegation – 1 person;

Coaches – 2 persons;

Referees – 2 persons. Each country is allowed to enter up to two athletes in each weight category.

Each delegation must provide the Organizing Committee with two national flags (120 cm × 180 cm) and an electronic version of the national anthem recording.

5. Competition Conditions

The competitions shall be held in the classical style of Belbogli Kurash among men and women, in accordance with the current international refereeing rules of Belbogli Kurash, under the supervision of the refereeing panel of the Uzbekistan Federation of Belbogli Kurash. In each weight category, first place, second place, and two third places shall be awarded.

6. Financing

Expenses related to the organization and conduct of the competitions shall be covered jointly by the Khokimiyat of Fergana Region of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the Asian Confederation of Belbogli Kurash, and the Uzbekistan Federation of Belbogli Kurash, and shall be distributed according to additional written agreements between the parties. Travel expenses of the participants of the Asian Championship shall be covered by the sending organizations. Expenses for accommodation and meals of delegation participants of the Asian Championship

from national federations (13 athletes, 1 head of delegation, 2 coaches, 2 referees) shall be covered by the host side.

7. Awards

Athletes who take 1st, 2nd, and two 3rd places in their respective weight categories shall be awarded certificates, medals, and valuable prizes from the Organizing Committee.

8. Safety and Security of Participants and Spectators

The safety and security of participants and spectators at the sports competition shall be ensured in accordance with the requirements of the Rules for Ensuring Safety during Official Sports Competitions. The Chief Referee of the competition is obliged, in accordance with the Recommendations on ensuring safety and injury prevention in physical education and sports, to:

inspect the condition and readiness of the competition venue, equipment and inventory, and the premises for the secretariat and referees, ensure the availability of an act confirming the suitability of the facility for hosting sports and entertainment events, and sign the Act of readiness of the sports facility for the competition;

start the competition only in the presence of an on-duty doctor or an on-duty medical team;

allow athletes to compete only upon presentation of the original accident insurance contract (insurance policy) covering life and health (insurance of athletes shall be provided by the sending organizations). Responsibility for personal safety, including insurance, lies solely with the participant of the competition. The organizing body and the refereeing panel shall not bear any responsibility for any physical injury to a participant of the competition, for their life, damage to their property, or loss of property during the competition. The owners (or operators) of sports facilities shall ensure public order and public safety.

9. Submission of Applications for Participation

A preliminary application containing information about athletes (including referee and coach–representative) participating in international sports competitions shall be submitted 10 days prior to the start of the competition to the Organizing Committee at the following addresses: Uzbekistan Federation of Belbogli Kurash Postal code: 111703. The following documents must be attached to the application for each athlete: copy of the athlete’s passport or international passport; insurance contract (original).

10. Summary and Results Conditions Within 3 days after the end of the competition, the Chief Referee must submit the following to the Asian Confederation of Belbogli Kurash and the International Belt Wrestling Federation:

Approved competition protocols in both paper and electronic formats. A written report on the competition and a ranking of the referees who officiated the event.

These Regulations serve as the official invitation to the competition.
